

ly during the irrigation season forty-eight (48) cubic feet of water per second of time, or such greater quantity as may be required for the irrigation of said quantity of land.

No. 13—The Fremont County Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 11; that said ditch takes its water from the Arkansas River; that said ditch is owned by The Fremont County Irrigating Ditch Company; that its headgate is located at a point on the South side of said River twenty-five and eight tenths (25.8) chains North and two and five tenths (2.5) chains west from the South East corner of section 2, Township 19 South Range 70 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of four hundred and twenty-five (425) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the persons entitled thereto, under and by virtue of said priority No. 11, continuously during the irrigating season, seventeen (17) cubic feet of water per second of time, or such greater quantity as may be required for the irrigation of the said 425 acres of land.

No. 14—The Craig-Beckham Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 12, 21, 34 and 41, which are Four Mile Creek priorities Nos. 3, 5, 11 and 15; that said ditch draws its water from Four Mile Creek; that the owners of said ditch are John H. Terry, Mills Craig and George H. Green, each of whom owns an undivided one third thereof; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the West side of said Creek, at a point eight and sixty-two hundredths chains east of the center of Section 10, Township 18 South of
