

Range 70 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seventy-five (75) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Mills Craig, under and by virtue of said priority No. 12, one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate six (6) acres of land belonging to said Craig; that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 20, continually during the irrigating season, for the irrigation of 15 acres owned by said Terry, 9 acres owned by said Craig, 10 acres owned by one Ida Burroughs and twenty-four (24) acres owned by George H. Green (58 acres in all under priority No. 21) two and thirty-two hundredths (2.32) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of George H. Green, under and by virtue of priority No. 34, one cubic foot of water per second of time and during such time and times as shall be required to properly irrigate three (3) acres of land; and, also, that said last named cubic foot of water be allowed to run in said ditch under and by virtue of priority No. 41 for such additional time and times as shall be necessary to properly irrigate eight (8) additional acres of land belonging to said George H. Green.

No. 15—The Henderson's Hardscrabble Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 13, which is also Hardscrabble Creek priority No. 2; that said ditch is owned by A. C. Henderson; that said ditch takes its water from said Hardscrabble Creek, and its headgate is situate on the North West side thereof at a point whence the common corner of sections 17, 18, 19 and 20 in Tp 19 S R
