

David C. Green, who owns an undivided one eighth, and William P. Flesher who uses water therefrom by arrangement with said owners; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred and fifty-five (155) acres of land; and there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the persons entitled thereto, under and by virtue of said priority No. 19, one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as is necessary for the proper irrigation of fifteen and one half (15½) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of the parties entitled thereto, under and by virtue of said priority No. 24, continually during the irrigating season, the further amount of five and fifty-eight hundredths (5.58) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 20—Canon City and Oil Creek Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 20 & 34; that said ditch takes its water from the Arkansas River; that said ditch is owned by The Canon City and Oil Creek Ditch Company; that its headgate is situate at a point North 57 degrees and 45 minutes East, 1256 feet from the South West corner of Sec. 32, Tp. 18 S. R. 70 West 6th p. m.; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 840 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 20, continually during the irrigating season, for the use and benefit of the persons entitled thereto, fourteen and two tenths (14.2) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be also allowed to flow into said ditch for the uses aforesaid, under and by virtue of said priority No. 34, continually during the irrigation sea-
