No. 21—The Wafford Ditch.

That said ditch takes its water from Four Mile Creek; that said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 22, 32, 51 and 336, which are said Four Mile Creek priorities Nos. 6, 10, 20 and 72 respectively; that Jesse Rader owns and undivided three eighths ($\frac{3}{8}$) of said ditch, William A. Stump an undivided three eighths ($\frac{3}{8}$), and the County of Fremont an undivided one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of (111) acres of land; that the head-gate of said ditch is located on the East side of said creek near the center of the North West quarter of Section 23, Tp. 18 South, Range 70 West; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 22, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use and benefit of Jesse Rader and William A. Stump and their heirs and assigns two and thirty-six hundredths (2.36) cubic feet of water per second of time; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of priority No. 32, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use and benefit of the County of Fremont, the further amount of one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 51, constantly during the irrigation season, for the use and benefit of said William A. Stump and his heirs and assigns, the further amount of sixteen hundredths (0.16) of one cubic foot of water per second of time; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 336, for
