

and Eldred; and under and by virtue of said priority No. 42, for such further time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate one acre of land owned by said Smith and five acres of land owned by said Thompson and Eldred; and that under and by virtue of said priority No. 118 said water shall be further allowed to flow into said ditch for such further time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate seven acres of land owned by said Smith and twenty acres owned by said Thompson and Eldred; and that under and by virtue of said priority No. 308 said water shall further be allowed to flow into said ditch for such further time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate two (2) acres of land owned by said August Smith and which he has cleared up and irrigated since the year 1883.

No. 27—The South Canon Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 30, 240 and 273; that said ditch is owned by The South Canon Ditch Company; that said ditch, at times, draws its supply of water from said Arkansas River and at other times from Grape Creek, a tributary of said river; that so far as other ditches taking water from said Arkansas River are concerned it is immaterial from which of said streams this ditch takes its water; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five hundred and eighty (580) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the persons entitled thereto, under and by virtue of said priority No. 30, continually during the irrigation season eight and six tenths (8.6) cubic feet of water per second of time; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the persons entitled thereto, under and by virtue of priority No. 240, constantly during the irrigation sea-
