

son, the additional amount of three and four tenths (3.4) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the persons entitled thereto, continually during the irrigation season, under and by virtue of said priority No. 273, the additional amount of twenty-three and two tenths (23.2) cubic feet of water per second of time; that when said ditch is drawing water from said Arkansas River it shall not, at such time, draw water from said Grape Creek in excess of an amount which, in addition to the amount it is then drawing from said River, will increase the amount in said ditch to the quantity herein decreed to said ditch, and vice versa; and when said ditch is drawing from one of said streams all the water it is entitled to under this decree it shall not be entitled to any water from the other of said streams.

No. 28—The Cottage Rock Ranch Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 30, 49, 169 and 371, which are also Four Mile priorities Nos. 9, 19, 52 and 83 respectively; that said ditch takes water from Four Mile Creek; that Marshall P. Felch is the owner of said ditch; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the East side of said creek in the South East quarter of the South East quarter Sec. 20, Tp. 17 South Range 70 West; and is about 34 rods West and 20 yards South from the North East corner of said forty acre tract; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Felch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 30, three cubic feet of water per second of time, or as much thereof as shall be necessary, for two days in each ten days, or for such less time as shall be found necessary
