

for the irrigation of 20 acres of land; and that said three cubic feet of water per second of time, or such less amount as shall be found necessary for the irrigation of the lands hereinafter specified, shall be allowed to flow in said ditch for the use of said Felch and his heirs and assigns, for one additional day in each ten days, or for such part thereof as shall be necessary to irrigate said lands as follows, to-wit: under said priority No. 49 to irrigate six (6) acres of land, and under said priority No. 169 to irrigate one and one half (1½) acres, and under said priority No. 371, to irrigate one half acre.

No. 29—The Adam Studt Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 31, 48 and 208, which are also Eight Mile Creek priorities Nos. 1, 4 and 8; that said ditch is owned by Adam Studt; that said ditch takes water from Eight Mile Creek; that its headgate is located at a point on the East side of said creek 1429 feet North and 245 feet West of the quarter corner on the East line of Sec. 9, Tp. 18 S. Range 69 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 50 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Studt, under and by virtue of said priority No. 31, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary to properly irrigate fifteen (15) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Studt, continually during the irrigation season, under and by virtue of priority No. 48 one cubic foot of water per second; and that the cubic foot of water herein decreed to run in this ditch for such time and times as shall be necessary to
