

irrigate 15 acres of land under priority No. 31 be allowed to run in said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Studt, under and by virtue of said priority No. 208 for such additional time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate ten additional acres.

No. 30—The Banks Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 33 and 188, which are also Adobe and Mineral Creek priorities Nos. 1 and 6 respectively; that the owners of said ditch are the heirs of Thomas R. Rule, deceased, who are Margaret Rule, his widow, John W. Rule, Harriet Sayton, Gabriel F. Rule, James Rule, Sarah Cheeley, Samuel H. Rule, Dicy Sullivan, Belle Dodson, Silas Rule, and Ida Burroughs, his children, each owning the share which the statute gives in case of intestate estates; that said ditch is used to irrigate 35 acres of land with water taken from this ditch alone, and 53 acres irrigated with water taken from this and from the Mineral Creek Ditch together; that said ditch takes its water from Adobe Creek, and that its headgate is located on the north side thereof; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch from said Adobe Creek for the uses aforesaid and for the benefit of said heirs of Thomas R. Rule and their heirs and assigns, and under and by virtue of said priority No. 33 one cubic foot of water per second of time for seven days in each sixteen days or such less time as shall be sufficient to irrigate said 35 acres of land; and that the rights of this ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 188, be as hereinafter set forth in connection with the Mineral Creek Ditch; that the rights of this ditch under its priority No. 188 are not, in any manner, subject or subordinate to the
