

virtue of said priority No. 399, for the use and benefit of said Hillier and Jones, constantly during the irrigation season, the still further amount of forty-one hundredths (0.41) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 32—The Pauls Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority Nos. 34, 54 and 220, which are also Adobe and Mineral Creek priorities 2, 3 and 8 respectively; that Edward F. Gould is the owner of said ditch as originally constructed and that William Barker is the owner of the extension thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten acres of land owned by said Edward F. Gould; and that said extension of said ditch is used, in connection with the Barker Ditch, to irrigate fifty acres of land owned by said William Barker; that said ditch takes its water from Mineral Creek, and that its headgate is located on the North West side thereof on the North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section 27, Tp. 20 South, Range 69 West; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use aforesaid and for the benefit of said Edward F. Gould under and by virtue of said priority No. 34 one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for two days (2) in each eight (8) days, or for such less time as shall be sufficient to irrigate said ten acres of land, the times to be chosen by the owner of the ditch; and that the amounts of water allowed to this ditch for said extension, and under and by virtue of said priorities No. 54 and 218, shall be as decreed in connection with the Barker Ditch in this decree; and that no right of this ditch is, in any manner subject to, or subordinate to any priority of the Banks Ditch.
