

No. 33—The W. H. May Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 34 and 161, which are also Oak Creek priorities Nos. 1 and 2 respectively; that said ditch takes its water from Oak Creek; that said ditch is owned by the town of Rockvale, a duly incorporated town situate in the County of Fremont; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the North West side of said creek at a point South 44 degrees and 17 minutes West, 6696 feet, from the South East corner of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25 Tp. 19 South, Range 70 West of the 6th p. m.; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 80 acres of land, part of which lies within the said town of Rockvale, and for domestic purposes within and by said town; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 34, continually the year around, for the irrigation of land within said town two and ninety-six hundredths (2.96) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 161, for the use and benefit of said town, continually, the further amount of one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 34—The Garden Park Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 35, 85, 305 and 343, which are also Four Mile Creek priorities Nos. 12, 29, 67 and 77; that said ditch takes its water from said Four Mile Creek; that its headgate is located on the East side of said creek at a point in the North West quarter of the South East quarter of Sec. 9, Tp. 17 South,
