

as shall be necessary for the irrigation of thirty acres of land owned by said Ira L. Porter; the whole amount of water decreed to this ditch being three and one quarter (3.25) cubic feet per second of time, all of which amounts of water above decreed to this ditch to be allowed to flow in said ditch continuously unless not needed for the purpose aforesaid.

No. 36—The Terry Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 37, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 13; that it takes its supply of water from Four Mile Creek; that The Reynolds Cattle Company, a corporation, is the owner thereof; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the West side of said creek at a point in the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section 9, Tp. 17 South, Range 70 West, from which point the middle of the South line of said Section is South 44 degrees and 45 minutes distant 24 chains; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of six (6) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said, for the use and benefit of the said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 37, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said six acres of land.

No. 37—The Aaron Ripley Ditch.

That said ditch takes its supply of water from Four Mile Creek; that it is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 39, 320 and 370, which are also Four Mile Creek priorities Nos. 14, 71 and 82; that Aaron
