

ity No. 41, which is also Hardscrabble Creek priority No. 8; that Annie E. Blake is the owner thereof; that it draws its water from the South fork of Hardscrabble Creek, and its headgate is located on the North side thereof at a point whence the South East corner of Sec. 11 Tp. 22 South, Range 69 West, County of Custer, bears South 45 degrees and 20 minutes East 933 feet; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Annie E. Klake, under and by virtue of said priority No. 41 one and one eighth ( $1\frac{1}{8}$ ) cubic feet of water per second of time or so much thereof as shall be needed for the irrigation of 90 acres of land now irrigated from said ditch.

#### No. 40—The Burnett Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 41, 131 and 297, which are also Eight Mile Creek priorities Nos. 2, 7 and 9 respectively; that said ditch takes its water from Eight Mile Creek, and that its headgate is located on the East bank of said creek at a point whence the South East corner of Sec. 15, Tp. 18 South, Range 69 West bears South 61 degrees and 58 minutes East 1771.44 feet; that said ditch is owned by E. H. Burnett and is by him used for the irrigation of 15 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Burnett, under and by virtue of priority No. 41 (this, The Monteville Ditch and The Craig-Beckham Ditch, being entitled to portions of the same priority) one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate ten (10) acres of land; and that said cubic foot of water be allowed to further flow in said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Burnett, under and by
