

virtue of priority No. 131, for such additional time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate two (2) additional acres of land; and that said cubic foot of water per second of time be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Burnett, under and by virtue of priority No. 297, for such still further time and times as shall be necessary to properly irrigate three (3) additional acres of land.

#### No. 41—The Adams Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 43, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 17; that said ditch takes its supply of water from said Four Mile Creek, and that its headgate is located at a point on the East side of said creek in the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Sec. 4, Tp. 17 South, Range 70 West, from which point the middle of the South line of said Section 4 is distant sixty-six and eight tenths chains in a direction South thirty-three degrees and 40 minutes West; that said ditch is owned by The Reynolds Cattle Company; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eighteen (18) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said The Reynolds Cattle Company, under and by virtue of said priority No. 43, one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate said eighteen acres of land.

#### No. 42—The 1869 Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 43; that said priority No. 43 is also Hardscrabble Creek priority No. 9; that Henry Burroughs is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-five (35) acres of land; that said
