

allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Tong, under and by virtue of said priority No. 365, for such additional time and times as shall be necessary to irrigate six (6) acres in addition to the before mentioned fifteen acres; the total amount decreed to this ditch being an amount not exceeding two cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 45—The Howard Ditch (Four Mile Creek.)

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 46, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 18; that said ditch takes its water from West Four Mile Creek and has the first priority of said West Four Mile Creek; that its headgate is located on the North side thereof; that said ditch is owned by William H. Grose; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Grose, under and by virtue of said priority No. 46, one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said twenty acres of land.

No. 46—The Hill Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 47 and 167, which are also Texas Creek priorities Nos. 1 and 34 respectively; that said ditch is owned by Henry N. Likely; that said ditch takes water from Texas Creek, and its headgate is situate in the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, Tp. 47 N., Range 12 East at a point S 8 degrees and 35 minutes East, 2473 feet, from the North West corner of said Section; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty (40) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of
