

said Likely, under and by virtue of said priority No. 47, one and five hundred and twenty-one ten thousandths (1.0521) cubic feet of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary for the proper irrigation of twenty-five (25) acres of land; and that said quantity of water be, further, allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Likely, under and by virtue of priority No. 167, for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the proper irrigation of fifteen additional acres of land.

No. 47—The Hill Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 47 and 132, which are also Texas Creek priorities Nos. 1 and 24; that said ditch takes its water from said Texas Creek and its headgate is situate on the West side of said creek in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 12, Tp. 47 North, Range 12 East, at a point S 24 degrees and 10 minutes East, 760 feet, from the North West corner of said Section; that said ditch is owned by Henry N. Likely; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 47, for the use and benefit of said Henry N. Likely, one and five hundred and twenty-one ten thousandths (1.0521) cubic feet of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of sixteen (16) acres of land; and that said quantity of water be, further, allowed to run in said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Likely, under and by virtue of said priority No. 132 for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the proper irrigation of four (4) additional acres of land.
