

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 48 and 178, which are also Eight Mile Creek priorities Nos. 4 and 7; that said ditch takes its water from said Eight Mile Creek, and that its headgate is situate on the West side of said creek at a point South 38 degrees and 20 minutes West, 930 feet, from the quarter corner on the East line of Sec. 9, Tp. 18 South, Range 70 West; that said ditch is owned by Adam Studt; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty (50) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Studts and his heirs and assigns, under and by virtue of priority No. 48, continually during the irrigation season, one and six-tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be, further, allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Studts and his heirs and assigns, under and by virtue of priority No. 178, continuously during the irrigation season, the further amount of four (4) tenths of one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 49—The Tenazzi Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 14, 38, 50 and 338, which are also Hardscrabble Creek priorities Nos. 3, 6, 11 and 58 respectively; that Llewelyn Rees is the owner of three fourths of said ditch and Benjamin Eggington is the owner of one fourth of said ditch; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-five (35) acres of land owned by said Rees and for the irrigation of fifteen (15) acres owned by said Eggington; that said ditch takes water from said Hardscrabble Creek, and its headgate is located on the West (or North West)
