

the irrigation season, or for such less time during said season as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said forty acres of land.

No. 51—The Hayden Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 53, which is also Hayden Creek priority No. 1; that said ditch is owned by Margaret Hayden; that said ditch takes its water from Hayden Creek, and its headgate is located on the West side of said creek in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 33, Tp. 48 N., R. 11 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Margaret Hayden, under and by virtue of said priority No. 53, one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time, which said amount shall be allowed to run in said ditch constantly.

No. 52—The Banks Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 54; that said ditch is owned by John E. Goode; that said ditch takes its water from said Arkansas River, and that its headgate is located on the North bank of said river a point to find which, from the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner on section line South of corner common to Sections 7, 12, 13 and 18, Tp. 19 S., Range 68 West; thence proceed South 5 degrees and 30 minutes East, 1080 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Goode, under and by virtue of said priority No. 54, one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said 20 acres of land.
