

No. 53—The George Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 55 and 123, which are also Four Mile Creek priorities Nos. 22 and 37 and (said priority No. 22 being the 2nd priority on West Four Mile Creek); that William H. Grose is the owner of said ditch; that the headgate is located on the South side of West Four Mile Creek, from which stream it takes its water; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seventy (70) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Grose, under and by virtue of priority No. 55, continuously during the irrigation season two (2) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be, further, allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Grose, under and by virtue of said priority No. 123 the further amount of eight tenths (0.8) of one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of twenty (20) additional acres of land.

No. 54—The Doris Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 56, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 23; that Henry A. Watson and John R. Witcher are the owners of said ditch, each of whom owns an undivided one half thereof; that said ditch takes its water from Four Mile Creek, and its headgate is located on the West side of said creek in the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Twp. 15. South, Range 71 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty (30) acres of land owned by said Watson and for thirty (30) acres of land owned by said Witcher;
