

and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Henry A. Watson and John R. Witcher and their heirs and assigns, constantly during the irrigation season, under and by virtue of said priority No. 56 two and four tenths (2.4) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 55—The Cascade Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 57, 164, 299, 333 and 402, which are also Hardscrabble Creek priorities Nos. 12, 32, 55, 62 and 45; that said ditch is owned by The Cascade Ditch Company; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seventy (70) acres of land belonging to Frances Wetmore, seventy-five (75) acres owned by Samuel C. Jerome, sixty (60) acres owned by Jason Blakeslee, fifty (50) acres owned by Jacob A. Betts, one hundred and forty (140) acres owned by William C. Parker, seventy-three acres owned by Orville W. Jones, and eighty-three acres owned by William P. Sikes and George W. Sikes (584 acres in all); that said ditch takes its water from Hadscrabble Creek, and that its headgate is on the East side of said creek in Sec. 10, Tp. 21 S., R. 69 West, in the County of Custer; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 57, for the irrigation of 70 acres owned by said Wetmore, 60 acres owned by said Blakeslee, 50 acres owned by said Betts, 60 acres owned by said Jerome, 95 acres owned by said Parker, and 50 acres owned by said Jones, and for the use and benefit of the heirs and assigns of said persons, and for the benefit of said The Cascade Ditch Company, four and eighty-one hundred and twenty-five ten thousandths (4.8125) cubic feet of water per second of time or so much thereof as shall be neces-
