

time, or so much thereof as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said forty-six (46) acres of land.

No. 56—The Kittridge Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 58, which is also Four Mile priority No. 24; that said ditch takes its water from West Four Mile Creek and is entitled to the 3d priority on said West Four Mile Creek; that Charles W. Kittridge is the owner thereof; that said ditch has its headgate on the North side of said creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred (100) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Kittridge, under and by virtue of said priority No. 58, constantly during the irrigating season, two cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 57—The Barker Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 59 and 221, which are also Adobe and Mineral Creek priorities Nos. 4 and 9; that William Barker is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch is used, in connection with the extension of The Pauls Ditch, to irrigate fifty (50) acres of land; that said ditch takes its water from Adobe Creek, and that its headgate is located on the West side of said creek; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, and into The Pauls Ditch and through the same into the extension thereof, for the benefit of said Barker and his heirs and assigns, under and by virtue of priorities Nos. 54 and 59, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for five days in each eight days, said days to be so chosen as to be different from the days chosen by the owner of the Pauls Ditch under Adobe and Mineral
