

Creek priority No. 2, or for such less time as shall be sufficient to irrigate twenty-five acres of said fifty acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow in said Barker Ditch, and into and through said Pauls Ditch and into said extension thereof, for the use and benefit of said William Barker, and under and by virtue of priorities No. 220 and 221, the further amount of one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for the further time of five days in each eight days, or for such less time as shall be sufficient to irrigate the other twenty-five acres of land above mentioned; that so far as sufficient water can be had therefrom without interference with prior right, said water so decreed to said Barker be taken through said Pauls Ditch under said priorities Nos. 54 and 220, The Pauls Ditch priorities, and that the remainder be taken through said Barker Ditch under said priorities Nos. 59 and 221, and that the water taken under said priorities Nos. 220 and 221 be so taken, as far as practicable, at times when ditches having older priorities are not taking water.

No. 58—The Hodges Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 60, which is also Cottonwood Creek priority No. 1; that Henry W. Hodges is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch takes its water from Cottonwood Creek, and its headgate is located on the North side of Squaw Creek at a point 48 degrees East 1811 feet, from the South West corner of Sec. 34, Tp. 16 S., R. 73 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-six (36) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 60, for the use and benefit of said Henry W. Hodges, two and five tenths (2.5) cubic feet of
