

water per second of time for as many periods, not exceeding four, of eight days each as may be necessary to irrigate eight acres of plowed land, and that said amount of water be allowed to flow in said ditch for as many additional periods, not exceeding six, of 14 days each, as may be necessary to irrigate twenty-eight acres of meadow land.

No. 59—The Corporan Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 61, which is also Hardscrabble Creek priority No. 13; that Henry M. Burroughs is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-five (35) acres of land; that said ditch takes its water from Hardscrabble Creek and its headgate is located at a point on said creek (East side) whence the South East corner of Sec. 35, Tp. 20 S., R. 69 West, bears N. 47 degrees and 15 minutes East, 1960 feet; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Burroughs, under and by virtue of said priority No. 61, one cubic foot of water per second of time for fourteen (14) days in each thirty-two (32) days, the times to be selected by said Burroughs but to be chosen so as to be at different times in the thirty-two (32) days from the time selected by the owner of the Tenazzi Ditch for his last six days above decreed to that ditch, so that this 14 and that six shall not conflict with each other; and that, if less time be sufficient to irrigate said thirty-five acres, then said water shall only be allowed to flow for such less time.

No. 60—The Hodges Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 62, which is also Cottonwood Creek priority
