

use and benefit of said Stephen Nichols, and under and by virtue of priority No. 191, the further amount of forty-six hundred and twenty-five ten thousandths (0.4625) of one cubic foot of water per second of time or so much thereof as shall be necessary to irrigate said thirty-seven acres of land; and, that, whenever the said creek will furnish the same over and above the quantity of two and seventy-one hundred and twenty-five ten thousandths cubic feet of water per second of time, there be further allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Breece, for the irrigation of one hundred and twenty-five acres (125), and under said priority No. 63 (though made subject to said priorities Nos. 136 and 191 when the water in the creek will not suffice for them) the further amount of one and fifty-six hundred and twenty-five ten thousandths (1.5625) cubic feet of water per second of time, or so much thereof as shall be necessary to irrigate said one hundred and twenty-five acres.

No. 62—The Schueler Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 64, 178 and 217, which are also Texas Creek priorities Nos. 2, 39 and 54, and said last named priorities are also Greenleaf Creek priorities Nos. 1, 4 and 6; that said ditch takes its water from Greenleaf Creek; that said ditch is owned by Jacob Schueler; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the South East bank of said Greenleaf Creek at a point whence the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec. 30, Tp. 21 S., R. 73 West 6th p. m. bears S. 54 degrees and 3 minutes E., 980 feet; that said ditch, together with The Schueler No. 2, The Schueler Ditch No. 3, The Schueler Ditch No. 4, The Schueler Ditch No. 5, The Schueler Ditch
