

No. 6, The Schueler Ditch No. 7 and the Schueler Ditch No. 8, is used to irrigate one hundred (100) acres of land; on what is known as the "Schueler Ranch" (said ranch being in Sections 29 and 30 in Tp. 21 S., R. 73 West); and that there be allowed to flow onto said Schueler Ranch, for the irrigation of ten (10) acres thereon, under and by virtue of priority No. 64, for the use and benefit of said Jacob Schueler, and through any one of said ditches the owner thereof may choose (but not through more than one at the same time) one and five hundred and twenty-five ten thousandths (1.0525) cubic feet of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said ten (10) acres of land; that said amount of water be further allowed to flow into any one of said eight ditches the owner may choose (but not into more than one at the same time) under and by virtue of priority No. 178, for the use and benefit of said Schueler, for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of thirty (30) additional acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said eight ditches, or either of them, or any number of them, constantly, for the use and benefit of said Schueler, under and by virtue of priority No. 217, the further quantity of one and fifty-seven hundred and eighty-eight ten thousandths (1.5788) cubic feet of water per second of time; the total amount of water herein decreed to said Schueler Ranch and for the irrigation of the one hundred acres irrigated thereon being two and six tenths (2.6) cubic feet per second of time.

**No. 63—The Schueler Ditch No. 2.**

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 64, 178 and 217, which are also Texas Creek
