

for such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of nine (9) acres of land, and that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the parties entitled thereto, under and by virtue of priority No. 172, for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of fourteen and one half (14½) acres of additional land.

No. 71—The Tremayne Brothers' Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 71, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 25; that said ditch takes its water from West Four Mile Creek and said priority No. 25 is also West Four Mile priority No. 4; that said ditch is owned by Richard Tremayne and John Trémayne, each of whom owns an undivided half thereof; that the head of said ditch is located on the South side of said West Four Mile Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty (50) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the said owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 71, two cubic feet of water per second of time, and that said amount be allowed to run constantly in said ditch during the irrigation season.

No. 72—McIntire Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 72, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 26, and West Four Mile priority No. 5; that said ditch is owned by Augustine Fromm, who owns one third thereof and Charles Kestle, who owns two thirds thereof; that said ditch takes its water from West Four Mile Creek and that its head is located on the
