

North side thereof; and that there be allowed to run in said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 72, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for such time and times as is sufficient to irrigate ten (10) acres owned by said Fromm and sixteen (16) acres owned by said Kestle.

No. 73—The Hilton Ditch.

That this ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 73, which is also Bernard Creek priority No. 1; that said ditch is owned by J. D. Hilton; that said ditch takes its water from Bernard Creek, and that its head is on the West side of said stream at a point in Sec. 31, Tp. 48 N., R. 12 E. of N. M. M., whence the Sec. corner common to Sections 25, 30, 31 and 36, in said Tp. and R. bears West, variation 14 degrees and 30 minutes East, 1060 feet; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Hylton, under and by virtue of said priority No. 73, one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land.

No. 74—The Rogers Ditch.

That this ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 73 and 139, which is also Lake Creek priorities Nos. 1 and 3, and Texas Creek priorities Nos. 4 and 27; that said ditch is owned by Henrietta E. Armstrong, who owns one fourth of said ditch, and J. J. Crippen, who owns three fourths thereof; that said ditch takes its water from Lake Creek and its head-gate is located on the South bank thereof in the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 34, Tp. 47 N., R. 12 East, 53
