

feet from the West line and 397 feet from the N. W. corner of said 40 acres tract; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty (20) acres owned by said Henrietta E. Armstrong and forty-six (46) acres owned by said Crippen; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 73, for the irrigation of 12 acres of land owned by said Crippen and 20 acres owned by said Armstrong, one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of thirty-two (32) acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Crippen, under and by virtue of priority No. 139, the further quantity of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of thirty-four (34) additional acres of land.

No. 75—The Hayden Ditch (Lake Creek.)

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 73 and 372, which are also Texas Creek priorities Nos. 4 and 102 and also Lake Creek priorities Nos. 1 and 12; that said ditch is owned by L. R. Hayden; that it takes its water from Lake Creek and its headgate is located on the North side thereof; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ninety-five acres (95) of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of said Hayden, under and by virtue of priority No. 73, continually, two and thirty-six hundredths (2.36) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of said Hayden, under and by virtue of priority No. 372, continually, the further quantity of thirteen hundredths of one cubic foot of water per second of time.
