

Texas Creek and its headgate is located on the West bank of said creek in the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 14, Tp. 47 N. R. 12 East; that said ditch is used for the the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land owned by said Likely and 40 acres owned by said McCormick; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Likely and McCormick, under and by virtue of priority No. 74, constantly, one and three hundred and twenty-one thousandths (1.321) cubic feet of water per second of time.

#### No. 79—The Mill Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 75 and 344, which are also Texas Creek priorities Nos. 6 and 95; that said ditch is owned by Thomas Vipond; that said ditch takes its water from said Texas Creek and its headgate is located on the West side of said creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifteen (15) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Vipond, under and by virtue of priority No. 75, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of land; and that said cubic foot of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Vipond, under and by virtue of priority No. 344, for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of seven (7) acres of additional land.

#### No. 80—The Toof Ditch Extension.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 76, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 18; that said ditch is owned by George H. Toof and
