

Adah R. Toof; that said ditch takes its water from Beaver Creek through The Toof Ditch No. 1; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-five (25) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said owners, under and by virtue of priority No. 76, one cubic foot of water per second of time, for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of twenty-five acres of land.

#### No. 81—The Draper Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 76 and 136, which are also Hardscrabble Creek priorities Nos. 20 and 33; that William W. Draper owns two thirds of said ditch and James L. Sheffield one third thereof; that said ditch takes its water from Hardscrabble Creek and its headgate is located on the West side thereof in the N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the S. W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 22, Tp. 21 S., R. 69 West in the County of Custer; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred and fifty-five (155) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said William W. Draper and James L. Sheffield, under and by virtue of priority No. 76, one and one fourth ( $1\frac{1}{4}$ ) cubic feet of water per second of time, and under and by virtue of priority No. 136, the further amount of sixty-eight hundred and seventy-five ten thousandths (0.6875) of one cubic foot of water per second of time, or so much thereof dred and fifty-five acres of land.

#### No. 82—The Uetley Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 76 and 242, which are also Hardscrabble Creek priorities Nos. 17 and 39, that James L.
