No. 85—The Winbourn Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 79, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 19; that John T. Sullivan owns two thirds of said ditch and Thomas Stuart one third; that said ditch takes its water from Beaver Creek; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said owners, under and by virtue of said priority No. 79, one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 86—The Schueler Ditch No. 4.

No. 87—The Schueler Ditch No. 5.

No. 88—The Schueler Ditch No. 6.

No. 89—The Schueler Ditch No. 7.

No. 90—The Schueler Ditch No. 8.

That said ditches: The Schueler Ditches Nos. 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 are entitled to the rights given them under, and in connection with, The Schuler Ditch No. 1.

No. 91—The Murphy Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 81, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 27; that said ditch is owned by John H. Terry; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the East side of said creek in the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 10, Tp. 18 S., R. 70 West at a point from which the middle of the South line of said Section is South 9 degrees and 30 minutes West, distant $47\frac{1}{2}$ chains; that said ditch is used to irrigate eight (8) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for
