

the use and benefit of said Terry, under and by virtue of priority No. 81, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said eight (8) acres of land.

No. 92—The McClure Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No. 82 and 397, which are also Beaver Creek priorities Nos. 20 and 52; that Francis Laroux owns one half of said ditch, James S. McCurry one fourth and both said James McCurry and Jesse Kelly claim the remaining one fourth; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-two acres of land owned by said McCurry, thirty acres owned by said Leroux, five acres (5) owned by said Kelley, four (4) acres owned by one Thomas Stuart, who uses by consent of all persons interested, and ten (10) acres by one Elijah Hall, who also uses said ditch by consent of the persons interested; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the irrigation of 22 acres owned by said McCurry, 4 acres owned by said Stewart, 30 acres owned by said Laroux, 5 acres irrigated by said Kelley and 6 acres irrigated and owned by said Hall, under and by virtue of priority No. 82, two and eighty-four (2.84) hundredths cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of said Hall, under and by virtue of said priority No. 397, the further quantity of four tenths (0.4) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 93—The Cottonwood North Side Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 84 and 242, which are also Cottonwood
