

each of them, for all future time, but for and during the time beginning at the hour of 12 o'clock noon, and ending at six o'clock in the morning of the Friday following, but this proviso shall affect no other ditches but those of said Daniel Hall and those of said George A. Hall taking water from the North prong of the middle fork of Tallahassee Creek.

#### No. 95—The Gomer Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 86 and 114, which are also Howard Creek priorities Nos. 1 and 2; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of sixty-five acres of land; that said ditch has two heads, or has a feeder from the creek in addition to its regular head, but that it has no additional right or rights under said extra head; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch from said Howard Creek, and through either head the owner may choose under and by virtue of priority No. 86, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be sufficient to irrigate twelve acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 114, constantly during the irrigation season the further quantity of two and twelve hundredths (2.12) cubic feet of water per second of time; that both headgates of this ditch are situate on the South side of Howard, or Flint, Creek.

#### No. 96—The Witcher Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 87, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 30; that said ditch takes its water from West Four Mile Creek and that it has the 6th priority on said West
