

Four Mile Creek; that John R. Witcher is the owner of said ditch; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the North side of said creek in the N. E. $\frac{3}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{3}{4}$ of Sec. 4, Tp. 15 S., R. 72 West, in the County of Park; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty (40) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Witcher, under and by virtue of said priority No. 87, one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time for and during the irrigation season.

No. 97—The Thomas Patton Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities Nos. 66, 88 and 137, which are also Beaver Creek priorities Nos. 14, 21 and 27; that said ditch is owned by Thomas Patton; that said ditch takes its water from the East side of said Beaver Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of nineteen and one half acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Patton, under and by virtue of priority No. 66, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of three acres of land; that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use aforesaid, under and by virtue of priority No. 88, said cubic foot of water per second of time for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of two additional acres of land; and that said cubic foot of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 137 for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of fourteen and one half acres of additional land; the total amount of water decreed to this ditch being one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time
