

No. 102—The Ritter Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 90, 273, 310 and 348, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 8, 79, 86 and 97; that said ditch takes its water from said Texas Creek and its head-gate is located on the East bank of said creek at a point whence the E. $\frac{3}{4}$ corner of Sec. 29, Tp. 21 S. R 73 West of 6th p. m bears S. 84 degrees and 15 minutes East 772 feet; that said is owned by A. J. Browning; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 45 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of said priority No. 90, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of 20 acres of land; that said amount of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 273 for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of five acres of additional land; that said quantity of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 310, for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of 6 acres of additional land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 348, continually, the further quantity of three hundred and sixty-eight thousandths (0.368) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.

No. 103—The Duckett Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 91, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 9; that said ditch takes its water from said Texas Creek, and that its headgate is located on the West
