Hayden; that said ditch is used for the irrigation 40 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Hayden, under and by virtue of said priority No. 91, one cubic foot of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said forty acres of land.

No. 104—The Vahldick Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 92 and 214, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 10 and 52, and Greenleaf Creek priorities No's 1 and 5; that said ditch is owned by Frederick Vahldick; that said ditch takes water from said Greenleaf Creek and its headgate is located on the N. W. bank of said creek at a point whence the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Sec. 29, Tp. 21 S, R 73 W bears N. 40 degrees and 30 minutes E, 435 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 80 acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Vahldick, under and by virtue of priority No. 92, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of thirty acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Vahldick, under and by virtue of priority No. 214, continually, the further amount of one and three tenths (1.3) cubic feet of water per second of time.
