

a point to line which run from $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. cor. between sections 13 and 14, Tp. 46 N, R 12 E, thence N 4 degrees and 15 minutes W, 442 feet, thence N. 10 degrees and 13 minutes W, 610 feet, to head of ditch; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of sixty acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Balman, under and by virtue of said priority No. 93, one and fifty-seven hundred and eighty-nine ten thousandths (1.5789) cubic feet of water per second of time; said amount of water to run constantly in the ditch.

No. 107—The Barnard Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 93, which is also Barnard Creek priority No. 2; that said ditch is owned by Ross M. Corp; that said ditch takes its water from said Barnard Creek, and that its headgate is located on the West bank of said creek at a point in Sec. 30, Tp. 48 N, R 12 E, whence the Sec. corner common to sections 25, 30 and 31 and 36 said Tp and R bears S. 28 degrees and 30 minutes W, 2486 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of ten (10) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Corp, under and by virtue of said priority No. 93, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said ten acres of land.

No. 108—The Lockhart Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 94, which is also Texas Creek priority No.
