

No. 110—The Hendrickson & Dissmore Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 95, which is also Brush Creek priority No. 3, and North Brush Creek priority No. 3; and Texas Creek priority No. 13; that said ditch is owned by N. B. Dissmore; that said ditch takes its water from said North Brush Creek, and its headgate is located on the North bank of said creek at a point whence the S. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner of Section 22, Tp. 46 N, R 12 E bears S. 23 degrees W, distance 2197 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 175 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said N. B. Dissmore, under and by virtue of priority No. 95, constantly, four and six tenths (4.6) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 111—The Gardner Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 96, which is also Main Tallahassee Creek priority No. 1; that said ditch is owned by Martin B. Gardner and Leonard W. Gardner; that said ditch takes its water from the main Tallahassee Creek, and that its headgate is located on the North, or left, side of said creek from which headgate the $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. corner on the line between Sections 15 and 22, Tp. 17 S, R 73 W bears S. 35 degrees W, distant 448 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-six and two tenths acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners of said ditch under and by virtue of said priority No. 95, two cubic feet of water per second of time for as many periods in each year, not exceeding three, of thirteen days each, as shall
