

be necessary for the irrigation of said 26.2 acres of land. Provided, however, that in accordance with a decree of the Court hereinbefore rendered that as between the said The Gardner Ditch No. 1 and the ditches owned by Kate Gorman,—The Gorman Ditch No. 1, The Gorman Ditch No. 2, The Gorman Ditch No. 3 and the Jim Ditch—the said The Gardner Ditch No. 1 shall have the exclusive right and privilege to use and divert all of the water flowing in said main Tallahassee Creek, for the purpose of irrigation, for five days in each and every week commencing at 6 P. M on Tuesday of each and every week, to and until the hour of 6 P. M on Sunday of each and every week, and that on all other days and times the said ditches of the said Kate Gorman shall have the exclusive right and privilege to divert all of the waters flowing in said main Tallahassee Creek, for the purpose of irrigation, but this proviso shall effect no other rights or priority than those of said The Gardner Ditch No. 1 and the said The Gorman Ditch No. 1, The Gorman Ditch No. 2, The Gorman Ditch No. 3 and The Jim Ditch.

No. 112—The Pauls Ditch, (also called the Frazier Ditch.)

That said ditch is entitled to the rights hereinafter decreed to it in connection with Grose's Extension of the Frazier Ditch.

No. 113—The Tremayne Brothers Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 98, which is also Four Mile Creek priority No. 34; and that the rights of this ditch are as hereinafter decreed in connection with The Tremayne Brother Ditch No. 4.
