

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 100, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 14 and Brush Creek priority No. 4; that said ditch is owned by Asa S. Gove; that said ditch takes its water from said Brush Creek, and its headgate is located on the West side of said creek at a point to find which commence at the section corner common to sections 1, 2, 11 and 12 in Tp. 46 N, R 12 E, thence S. 28 degrees and 30 minutes E, 17 chains, thence S, 47 degrees and 50 minutes E, fifty links to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of 50 acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Gove, under and by virtue of said priority No. 100, constantly, on and thirty-one hundred and fifty-seven ten thousandth (1.3157) cubic feet of water per second of time.

**No. 115—The Dissmore Ditch No. 2, McClurken's.**

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 101, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 15; that said ditch takes its water from said Texas Creek, and its headgate is located on the North West bank of said creek at a point whence the E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Sec. 31 Tp. 21 S, R 73 W, bears N. 19 degrees E, 925 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of the owner thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 101, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said 20 acres of land; that said ditch is owned by Sidney B. McClurken.
