

Mrs. Margaret Rule; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of three and one half acres of land; that said ditch takes its water from said Mineral Creek and from springs in the bed of said creek; that the headgate of said ditch is located on the West side of Mineral Creek in the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 28, Tp. 20 S, R 69 West; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch from said stream, for the use of said Rule, under and by virtue of said priority No. 103, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for two days in each twenty days; or, if the amount of water supplied by said springs is less than one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time, then that the same be allowed to flow into ditch for a proportionally longer time; that the Mineral Creek priority No. 5 of this ditch is not subject to Adobe and Mineral Creek priority No. 1 of The Banks Ditch.

No. 118—The Hugg Ditch No. 3.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 104, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 17; that said ditch is owned by Anna B. Hueber; that said ditch takes its water from said Texas Creek and its headgate is located on the South bank of said creek at a point whence the West quarter corner of Sec. 32, Tp. 21 S, R 73 West, in Custer County, bears N. 68 degrees and 24 minutes W, 1050 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty (40) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Hueber, under and by virtue of said priority No. 104, one and five hundred and fifty-five ten thousandth (1.0555) cubic feet of water per second of time, and that said
