No. 119—The Hugg Ditch No. 4.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 104, 241 and 382; which are also Texas Creek priorities No's, 17, 67 and 105; that said ditch is owned by Anna B. Hueber; that said ditch takes water from said Texas Creek and its headgate is located on the North West bank of said creek at a point whence the West $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec. 32, Tp. 21 S, R 73 West, in Custer County, bears North 85 degrees and 11 minutes West, 1132 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twenty-three acres; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Hueber, under and by virtue of said priority No. 104, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of 12 acres of land; that said cubic foot of water per second of time be further allowed to flow in said ditch, for the use of said Hueber, under and by virtue of priority No. 241 for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of land; and that said cubic foot of water per second of time be further allowed to flow in said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Hueber, under and by virtue of priority No. 382, for such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of three (3) acres of land; the total amount of water decreed this ditch being one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as is necessary for the irrigation of twenty-three acres of land.
