

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 105, 216, 296 and 364, which are also Hayden Creek priorities No's 2, 10, 15, and 17; that said ditch is owned by James Polsen and Albert Philips each of whom owns an undivided one half thereof; that said ditch takes its water from Hayden Creek, and that its headgate is located on the South bank of said creek in the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, Tp. 47 N, R 11 East; that the said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred and ten (110) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, constantly during the irrigation season, Four (4) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that of said quantity of water one and six tenths cubic feet per second of time shall flow into said ditch under and by virtue of priority No. 105, one cubic foot per second of time under and by virtue of priority No. 216, four tenths of a cubic foot under and by virtue of priority No. 296, and the balance thereof under and by virtue of priority No. 364.

No. 121—The Banta & Merit Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 107, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 22; that said ditch is owned by C. W. Banta, William E. Banta and Thomas E. Merit, each of whom owns an undivided one third thereof; that said ditch takes its water from said Beaver Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of thirty-nine (39) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of priority No. 107,
