

constantly during the irrigation season, one and fifty-six hundredths cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 122—The Upper Perry Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 108, which is also Beaver Creek priority No. 23; that said ditch is owned by Leverett S. Perry; that said ditch takes its water from said Beaver Creek; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 108, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of three (3) acres of land now irrigated from said ditch and lying above the outlet of the Second Perry Ditch, and also for the irrigation of one half of thirty-two acres lying under this ditch below the junction of The Second Perry Ditch.

No. 123—The Pleasant Valley Ditch, Muehlbach's.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 110, 163, 195, 219 and 281, which are also Hayden Creek priorities No's 3, 8, 9, and 11; that said ditch is owned by Louis Muehlbach; that said ditch takes its water from said Hayden Creek, and that its headgate is situate on the South side of said creek, in the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, Tp.— R.; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seventy (70) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Muehlbach, under and by virtue of priority No. 110, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of thirty (30)
