

acres of land, and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of said owner, the further quantity of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such additional time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of forty (40) acres of additional land; said cubic foot of water to run in said ditch one fourth of the time under and by virtue of priority No. 163, one fourth of the time under priority No. 195, one fourth of the time under and by virtue of priority No. 219, and one fourth of the time under and by virtue of priority No. 281.

No. 124—The Hoagg Ditch

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 111, which is also Hayden Creek priority No. 4; that Chauncy Hayden is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch takes its water from the West side of said Hayden Creek in the S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, Tp. 47 N, R 11 E; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of forty (40) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Hayden, under and by virtue of said priority No. 111, constantly during the irrigation season one and six tenths (1.6) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 125—The Stout Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 112, which is also Stout Creek priority No. 1; that said ditch is owned by Malissie E. Stout; that said ditch takes its water from the South side of said Stout Creek, in the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$, of Sec. 12, Tp. 48 N, R 10 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eighty (80) acres of land;
