

(70) acres of land and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of the owner, under and by virtue of said priority No. 115, continuously during the irrigation season, two and eight tenths (2.8) cubic feet of water per second of time, or such less amount as shall be sufficient to irrigate said seventy acres of land.

No. 130—The Gibbs Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 116, 209, 255 and 289, which are also Hardscrabble Creek priorities No's 22, 38, 40 and 43; that said ditch is owned by Albert Schaefer, Ed. S. Gibbs and Mary Mathiew Bishop, said Schaefer owning one fourth, said Gibbs one half and said Bishop one fourth; that said ditch takes its water from South Hardscrabble Creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seventy (70) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, continuously for the irrigation of 22 acres owned by said Schaefer, 15 acres owned by said Bishop and 18 acres owned by said Gibbs, under and by virtue of priority No. 116, sixty-eight hundred and seventy-five ten thousandth (0.6875) of one cubic foot of water per second of time; that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Schaefer under and by virtue of priority No. 209, the additional quantity of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of additional land; that said cubic foot of water per second of time be further allowed to run in said ditch, for the irrigation of four (4) acres of land owned by said Gibbs, under and by virtue of priority No. 255, for such additional time and
