

Creek priorities No's 5 and 14; that said ditch is owned by Columbus Mann; that its headgate is located at a point on the South side of said Cottonwood Creek 100 yards above the headgate of The Cottonwood North Side Ditch herein decreed on; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of eight (8) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Mann, under and by virtue of priority No. 118, so much water as a ditch 12 inches wide, one foot deep and having a fall, or grade, of one quarter of an inch to the rod will carry for as many periods, not exceeding three of four days each, as shall be sufficient to irrigate 4 acres of land; and that said amount of water be further allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 242, for as many additional periods, not exceeding three, of four days each, as shall be sufficient to irrigate four additional acres of land.

No. 133—The Gardner Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 118, which is also main Tallahassee Creek priority No. 2; that said ditch is owned by Martin B. Gardner and R. A. Gardner; that the headgate of said ditch is situate on the North, or left, side of main Tallahassee Creek, from which headgate the N. W. corner of Sec. 24, Tp. 17 S, R 73 West, bears N 25 degrees and 35 minutes E, 1666 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of twelve and eight tenths acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 118, one and one half cubic feet of water per second of time for three (3) periods, of six and one half days each.
