

used for the irrigation of seventy-five acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Balman, under and by virtue of priority No. 119, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of four (4) acres of land; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch for the use aforesaid, under and by virtue of priority No. 182, continuously, the further quantity of two and twelve hundredths (2.12) cubic feet of water per second of time.

#### No. 135—The John Watson Ditch.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 119, which is also Hardscrabble Creek priority No. 24; that said ditch is owned by Margaret A. Walters, Catherine Hopper, M. A. Essmeier, William Smith and W. S. Harmon; that said ditch draws its water from said Hardscrabble Creek, and its headgate is situate on the East side of said Creek at a point within the N. E.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of Sec. 10, Tp. 21 S, R 69 West; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of three (3) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use of the owners thereof, under and by virtue of said priority No. 119, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of the three (3) acres of land now irrigated therefrom.

#### No. 136—The Gorman Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 120, which is also main Tallahassee Creek priority No. 3; that said ditch is owned by Kate Gorman; that the headgate of said ditch is located on
