

No. 19; that said ditch is owned by Lyman Hayden; that said ditch takes water from said Texas Creek, and its headgate is situate on the East side thereof in the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 26, Tp. 47 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty (50) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Hayden, under and by virtue of priority No. 121, continuously, one and thirty-one hundred and fifty-seven hundredths (1.3157) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 138—The Belknap Ditch No. 2.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 122, which is also Texas Creek priority No. 20 and Lake Creek priority No. 2; that said ditch is owned by Henry Belknap; that said ditch takes water from Lake Creek, and its headgate is situate on the East side thereof, at a point to find which commence at said point on the South boundary of the N. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 26, Tp. 47 N, R 12 E, and run from said point of beginning N. 46 degrees E, 2 chains and 10 links, thence N 85 degrees and 30 minutes East, 9 chains and 20 links to headgate; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifteen (15) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Belknap, under and by virtue of priority No. 122, one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said 15 acres of land.

No. 139—The John Howard Ditch

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 122, and 310, which are also Texas
