

Wright; that said ditch takes its water from said Newland Creek, and that its headgate is located on the West bank of said creek; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of five (5) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the benefit of said Wright, under and by virtue of priority No. 123, one half of one cubic foot of water per second of time for and during such time and times as shall be necessary for the irrigation of said five acres of land.

**No. 144—The Dissmore Ditch No. 1.**

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 123 and 253, which are also Texas Creek priorities No's 21 and 72; that N. B. Dissmore is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch takes its water from the said North Dissmore Creek, and its headgate is located on the North bank of said creek at a point whence the North quarter Section corner of section 11, Tp. 46 N., R. 12 East bears N. 48 degrees and 17 minutes, 1594 feet; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of fifty (50) acres of land; that there be allowed to flow into said ditch for the use and benefit of said Dissmore, under and by virtue of priority No. 123, continually, one and five hundredths (1.05) cubic feet of water per second of time; and that there be further allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use of said Dissmore, under and by virtue of priority No. 253, constantly, the further quantity of twenty-six hundredths (0.26) of one cubic foot of water per second of time.

**No. 145—The Houle Ditch No. 1.**

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priority No. 124, which is also Texas Creek priority
