

No. 22, Brush Creek priority No. 6, and South Brush Creek priority No. 2; that Elizabeth Houle is the owner of said ditch; that the headgate of said ditch is on the East side of the South Fork of Brush Creek at a point South 5 degrees West, 750 feet distant, from the West side quarter section corner of Sec. 13, Tp. 46 N, R 12 East; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of seventy (70) acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, for the use and benefit of said Houle, under and by virtue of said priority No. 124, constantly, two and one tenth (2.1) cubic feet of water per second of time.

No. 146—The Kittridge Ditch No. 1.

That said ditch is entitled to Arkansas River priorities No's 125 and 187, which are also Four Mile Creek priorities No's 38 and 55; that said priority No. 125 is the 6th priority on the upper part of Four Mile creek, and is the 3d priority above the mouth of West Four Mile Creek; that Charles W. Kittridge is the owner of said ditch; that said ditch is located on the West side of Four Mile Creek, in the County of El Paso; that said ditch is used for the irrigation of one hundred and twenty-five acres of land; and that there be allowed to flow into said ditch, under and by virtue of priority No. 125, two and one third (2.1-3) cubic feet of water per second of time for such time and times as shall be found necessary for the irrigation of said one hundred and twenty-five acres of land; and, that under and by virtue of said priority No. 187, the further quantity of two cubic feet of water per second of time shall be allowed to flow into said ditch for such time and times as shall be sufficient to irrigate said lands; that, as the lands
